

Panic Button System Installation & Testing Instructions

INSTALLATION:

1. Select a central location for the console.
2. Plug the AC adapter into a power outlet that's not controlled by a wall switch
3. Connect the console's telephone cord to a telephone outlet. If there already is a telephone plugged into the outlet, disconnect the telephone from the outlet and plug it into the jack on the bottom of console labeled "PHONE".
4. Slide the console's POWER switch to ON. The console should sound two beeps and announce "timer off". The green POWER indicator should light steady.

EMERGENCY BUTTON TESTING:

The emergency buttons should be tested from various locations around the console to verify the console's ability to receive the emergency button's signal.

1. Use a pencil or other narrow object to momentarily press the console's TEST button once.
2. The console will announce "test mode" and the POWER indicator will go dark.
3. Press the button on the emergency button from various locations. Each time the emergency button's signal is received, the console will announce "emergency sensor zone 1".
4. Three minutes after entering Test Mode, the console will announce "timer off" and return to normal operation.

NOTE: ACTIVATING THE REMOTE CONTROL WHILE THE CONSOLE IS NOT IN TEST MODE WILL CAUSE AN ACTUAL ALARM. IN THIS CASE, PRESS THE CLEAR BUTTON TO CANCEL THE ALARM.

TELEPHONE LINE TESTING:

To verify that the console is correctly connected to the telephone line for programming and alarm reporting perform either of the two following tests.

1. If a local telephone is connected to the console, lift the handset on the telephone and check for a dial tone to verify that the telephone is working.
2. Use a telephone from another location or cell-phone to call the telephone number that the console is connected to. Let the telephone ring twice then hang up. Wait 10-15 seconds and call the console again. If the console answers and sounds a loud tone, the telephone line is connected correctly and working properly.
